A brief history



EFSA was established under **EU law in 2002** following a series of food crises as part of a programme to:

improve

the EU food safety system

help ensure

a high level of consumer protection

restore and maintain

confidence in the EU food supply

clearly separate

risk assessment and risk management functions

Transparency Regulation



- October 2017 Citizens' initiative on glyphosate
 - Concerns about quality and independence of scientific studies
 - Call for greater transparency of the EU risk assessment
- December 2017 Commitment to introduce a new legislation
- September 2019 Adoption of Transparency Regulation
- March 2021 Entry into application




