Statement

- Old fashion legislation based on strict technical rules and sampling as the tool for verification of safety of food in previous decades
- EU approved monitoring programmes of VMPs residues from 2007.
- National legislation In line with EU Hygiene rules from 2011.
- Food and Veterinary Office / EU audits for upgrading and improving of FS system
- Risk based approach to food safety microbiological and chemicals assessment, official controls, prevention and eradication of food borne pathogens
- Active cooperation and participation in international organization EFSA, OIE, WHO/FAO



Statement

- Additional monitoring of food and feed safety, zoonotic diseases, border control
 as tool for facilitation of trade agreements and based on relevant scientific
 opinions and reached experience from 2017
- BSE recognition as country with negligible risk
- Categorization of food establishments in line with EU requirements
- Classification of animal by products facilities in EU requests and upgrading of ABP system
- EU approved export of various foodsuffs
- Regionalization of countries related to appearance of animal diseases



Statement

Further steps:

- Continuing work on accession to the EU using EU projects, trainings of competent authorities and stakeholders, inter-laboratory cooperation with EULabs, regional straitening
- Drafting of status for free of certain diseases
- Re-organization of services, vaccination of animals as the measures for eradication of diseases, implementation of new official control and animal health laws
